The school sends this letter of recommendation to *every* college to which a student applies.

Students maintain their Student Resume throughout their career at University High School. Besides the college preparatory curriculum, students should not overlook activities outside the classroom. Participation in clubs, student government organizations, sports, fine and performing arts, community service and employment give college admissions representatives a picture of how you might contribute to their community.
