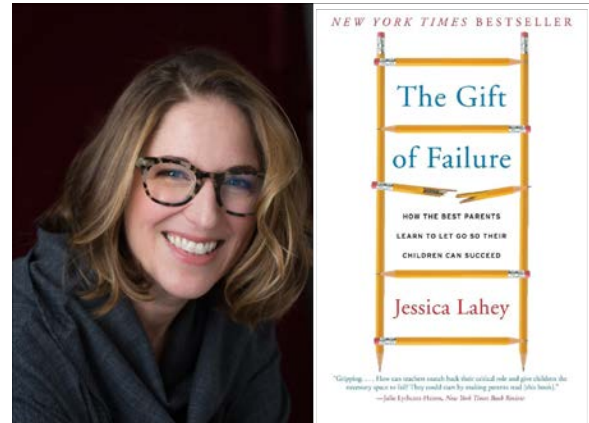
The University High School Parent Association invites you to **PArty in the Pines on Wednesday, Nov. 30 from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m.**

## Coolidge Scholarship, Deadline Feb. 23, 2023

The Coolidge Scholarship is a full-ride, four-year merit scholarship that may be used by recipients for undergraduate study at any accredited college or university in the United States. Any high school junior who plans to enroll in college in the fall of 2024 and is an American citizen or legal permanent resident is eligible to apply (current high school seniors are not eligible to apply). Winners may use the scholarship to pursue any academic major.

Academic excellence is the primary criterion considered by the Coolidge Scholarship. Secondary criteria include an interest in public policy and an appreciation of the values President Coolidge championed.
